

OSSTF D16 **Human Rights Day** Student Poster Competition Form

Application Rules

1. Eligible students must be a YRDSB student in grades 9-12.
2. One award, valued at three hundred dollars (\$300), will be given to the recipient.
3. The criteria used in the selection process will be based on the following:
 - a) The completed application form.
 - b) A visual poster, sent to the OSSTF D16 Human Rights Committee, that includes the following:
 - i) **Must be an original piece**
 - ii) **Poster can be in any visual arts medium (paint, pencil, mixed media, graphic design, charcoal, etc.) in the required size stated below**
 - iii) **Poster size must be 8.5" by 14" or 11" by 17"**
 - iv) **Must have the following information present on the poster:**
 - **Human Rights Day** (Noticeable Title)
 - **December 10th** (Please do not include the year)
 - c) An official copy of an up-to-date Credit Counselling Summary (which must include your mid-term marks) stamped using your school's seal.
4. All completed application packages must be received by the Human Rights Committee Poster Coordinator, Nicole Baxter-Lyn, at the District 16 OSSTF Office by 3:30 pm on MAY 18th, 2017.
5. Applications will be processed by the Human Rights Committee, and the winning candidate will be announced by June 1, 2017.
